## Chapter 6 (Disbursement-Level Records)

### Record type 09 (Pre-Disbursement Change)

- Added the following statement: “In an effort to synchronize all parties’ databases, the creator of a CAM record must be able to submit a replacement CAM record in a timely manner, when the original CAM record was rejected” (Issued 08/07/2006).

### Record type 10 (Post-Disbursement Change/Notification)

- Modified text related to Reissue/Reinstatement with date in the past or today’s date as follows (Issued 7/31/2008 Revision 1.2.0):
 

If the reissue/reinstatement is requested but the date of the reissue/reinstatement is in the past or today, only one Record type 10 is needed and it includes reissue/reinstatement information along with the notification data.
- Added ‘Reinstatement’ to the section discussing the process for Reissues with and date in the future and with a date in the past or today’s date (Issued 10/01/2007 Revision 1.1.0).
- Added missing text to the following statement: “Other guarantors do not track fee subsidies.

To assist these guarantors, lenders may convey fee subsidy information to guarantors via the CAM 10 record during disbursement notification. The guarantor will then use this information in new disbursement calculations, and may store the fee subsidies at the disbursement level for use in any subsequent net disbursement recalculation required by post disbursement changes” (Issued 10/01/2007 Revision 1.1.0)

- Added the following statement: “In an effort to synchronize all parties’ databases, the creator of a CAM record must be able to submit a replacement CAM record in a timely manner, when the original CAM record was rejected” (Issued 08/07/2006).
- Text was added to the Record type 10 overview section to clarify the calculation of net disbursement amount upon receipt of disbursement notification (Issued 08/07/2006).
- The following text was added to the Record type 10 overview section: *Although this use was implied in earlier versions of CAM documentation, the Record Type 10 may not be used to add a disbursement or to reinstate a cancelled amount if a partial post-disbursement cancellation has already been processed against the disbursement. Once an issued disbursement is cancelled in part, it is necessary to initiate an entirely new loan in order for the borrower to obtain additional funds (including even the previously cancelled amount)* (Issued 04/01/2005).
- Record Level Edit 071 was added (Issued 04/01/2005).
- Revision to second paragraph to clarify when a Record type 09 or Record type 10 should be sent (Issued 07/01/2001).
- Record Level Edit 054 was added (Issued 07/01/2001).
